### **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO HOLD SPECIAL MEETING WITH DOMINION POWER**

#### **PROPOSED NATURAL GAS PIPELINE TO BE DISCUSSED**

September 2, 2014 – The Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors has called a special meeting for Tuesday, September 9, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. to meet with representatives of Dominion Power regarding the Atlantic Coast Pipeline Project (natural gas pipeline). The proposed route of the pipeline will run through the Rice area of Prince Edward County.

The September 9<sup>th</sup> meeting will be held in the Prince Edward County Circuit Courtroom, located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of the Prince Edward County Courthouse, 111 South Street, Farmville, VA. The meeting is open to the public; however, following a presentation by Dominion Power, only citizens and/or landowners of Prince Edward County will be allowed to ask questions.

Currently, Dominion Power is not planning to hold a public meeting in Prince Edward County about the proposed natural gas pipeline. This Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors is the only scheduled opportunity for citizens of Prince Edward County to ask questions and get answers about the project.
