Public Hearing Notice NOTICE OF PROPOSED REAL PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

In accordance with Section 58.1-3321 of the *Code of Virginia*, as amended, notice is hereby given that the Prince Edward County Board of Supervisors will hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** on <u>Tuesday, April 15, 2025</u>, at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Room, Prince Edward County Courthouse, 111 N. South Street, 3rd Floor, Farmville, Virginia, to receive citizen input prior to considering the following:

The County of Prince Edward proposes to increase property tax levies.

- 1. Assessment Increase: Total assessed value of real property, excluding additional assessments due to new construction or improvements to property, exceeds last year's total assessed value of real property by 37 percent.
- 2. Lowered Rate Necessary to Offset Increased Assessment: The tax rate which would levy the same amount of real estate tax (General Fund) as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of real estate with the exclusions mentioned above, would be \$0.37 per \$100 of assessed value. This rate will be known as the "lowered tax rate."
 - The current tax rates are \$0.51 per \$100 of assessed value for the real estate tax rate (General Fund tax rate) and \$0.01 per \$100 of assessed value for the Emergency Medical Service (EMS) District on the real estate tax rate.
- 3. Effective Rate Increase: The County of Prince Edward proposes to adopt a tax rate of \$0.39 per \$100 of assessed value for real state tax rate (General Fund tax rate) and \$0.01 per \$100 of assessed value for the EMS District tax rate. The difference between the lowered tax rate and the proposed rate would be an increase of \$0.02 per \$100, or 5 percent for the General Funds tax rate and no change for the EMS District tax rate. This difference will be known as the "effective tax rate increase."
 - Individual property taxes may, however, increase at a percentage greater than or less than the above percentage.
- 4. Proposed FY26 Total Budget Increase: Based on the proposed real property tax rate and changes in other revenues, the total budget of the County of Prince Edward will exceed last year's by 69 percent.



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A breakdown of the proposed 69% budget increase is as follows:

- 61% is U.S. Department of Homeland Security pass-through funding for the operation of the ICA facility;
- 3% is allocated to the school operating budget and construction debt service; and
- 5% is for county operations, public safety, and capital improvements.

The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to the assessment of public service corporation property by the State Corporation Commission.
