Question: Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?

*Voters may register after this date, through Election Day, and vote using a provisional ballot that will be counted *after* the election, if accepted by the Electoral Board.

*Mailed voter registration applications must be received postmarked on or before the deadline.

Absentee Voting By Mail

Friday, April 10, 2026 : Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail. Applications **must be received** in the Office **by 5 p.m.** Request online: <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>

*If you have requested a mailed ballot and choose to vote in person, please bring your ballot with you when you come to vote.

*You may also bring and drop off your voted ballots at the Prince Edward Voter Registration and Elections Office, Floor 2N during regular business hours. Drop boxes will be available on Election day at each polling location.

Tuesday, April 21, 2026 : **Election Day!**

All Absentee voted ballots must be returned in person to the Registrar's Office by 7PM on Election Day to be counted or must be postmarked before or by election day and received by noon on Friday, April 24, 2026.
